- 1. Mimic us, tongue
- 2. Our attitudes towards life and God affect our children

(slide 3) Teaching about God is the responsibility of one generation to the next

Psa 78:5 He established the law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children, 6 so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children.

- 1. Multiply, nurture, and teach
- 2. 4 generations

- 3. The world is teaching them something else
 - a. Even more apparent these days
- 4. If we don't take the responsibility sometimes the rights are taken away from us

(slide 4) God's word does not change from one generation to another

Psa 119:89 Your word, Lord, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens. 90 Your faithfulness continues through all generations; you established the earth, and it endures.

- 1. There is no 2020 version of God's word
 - a. It does not adjust for every generation
- 2. God's principles never change
- 3. Nor his intension and his plans to bring us to the next heaven

(slide 5) Together generations live a life mindful of God's word and deeds

Psa 78:7 Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep his commands.

- 1. The presence of God in a household
- 2. One generation learned from another
- 3. Beauty of GSCC

(slide 6) Teach our children with understanding and daringness

Eph 6:4 Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

- 1. Guide the children at where they are
- 2. Respect them at where they are
- 3. Dare to discipline at where they are

(slide 7) We are the guardians of our children's hearts before Jesus captures theirs

Gal 3:23 Before the coming of this faith, we were held in custody under the law, locked up until the faith that was to come would be revealed.

- 1. The goal is always help them open their heart to Jesus
- 2. The milestone of mankind history, same as a child
